Christmas Masses at Garstang

Our Christmas Masses this year will be as follows:

- Friday 24 December, Christmas Eve, 6.00pm & 10.00pm.
- Saturday 25 December, Christmas Day, 10.30am. (Please note: there will be no Mass on the Saturday evening.)
- Sunday 26 December, Boxing Day, 10.30am.

We are mindful that we want our liturgies to be safe for all who attend.

Current mitigations against the virus will remain in place: hand sanitiser will be available as you enter the church, and our Bishops ask that face coverings continue to be worn by all who can and who are over 12 years of age.

In order to plan for this, we will be allocating seating, as we did last year, for the Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. There will be a maximum capacity of 200 for each Mass. There will be two households per bench with a maximum of four persons. For extended family households with children, this maximum can be up to seven per bench.

Please be aware that fire regulations mean that we can no longer use the balcony in the church and there can be no standing in the narthex or at the back of the church.
