- 5. For our sick, particularly those among our families and friends who suffer in mind or body; that the Lord will come with his peace and healing.
- For our faithful departed, those who are recently deceased, and those whose anniversaries occur about this time; that God grant them eternal peace and rest.
- 7. We ask Mary, mother of our Saviour, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...
