## Season of Advent : Sunday 4A General Intercessions

## **Priest**

The Lord's is the earth and its fullness, the world and all its peoples. In this season of hope, we pray for the Church and for the world.

## Reader

1. For the whole Church; that our life and our worship may faithfully proclaim the mystery of Jesus Christ, Emmanuel.

**PAUSE** for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

2. For the peace of the world;

for an end to all disputes between peoples and nations, religions, and races; for the work of the United Nations, and all who work far from home to help establish peace.

- 3. For those who are not looking forward to Christmas, and all who will spend their first Christmas alone; may they find consolation and hope in the coming of our Saviour.
- For all expectant mothers, especially any who may be troubled by anxiety or doubt; that Mary, Mother of our Saviour, will comfort them and nurture their hope.
- 5. For ourselves, our parish, and all who worship with us today; that like the Blessed Virgin and St Joseph, we will be open to hear the life-giving word of God.
- 6. For the faithful departed:

those who have died recently, and all whose anniversary we keep; that they will experience the fullness of Christ's resurrection from the dead.

7. We ask Mary, Mother of our Saviour, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...

## **Priest**

Pour forth, O Lord, your grace into our hearts: once through the message of an angel you revealed to us the incarnation of Christ your Son; now through his passion and cross lead us to the glory of his resurrection, who lives and reigns for ever and ever.
