Priest

The Spirit of God renews the face of the earth. In this season of hope and blessing, we pray for the Church and for the world.

Reader

1. For the Church:

that we may recognise our calling as God's sons and daughters and, with the power of the Holy Spirit, show God's love and compassion in word and deed.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

- 2. For a deepening of prayer in our life: that, like Jesus, we may grow in our relationship with God through prayer and listening.
- For all who have been baptised in our community, particularly during this last year: that they may be faithful disciples of Jesus, and continue to grow in their knowledge and love of God.
- 4. For all who are sick:

that God will heal those who are ill, bring an end to the Covid pandemic, and sustain all who care for the sick.

5. For young adults:

that they may respond to God's invitations to build up the Christian community and participate in the mission of the Church.

- 6. For the faithful departed, who have recognised Jesus as their Saviour; that he will gather them to himself in the glory of the kingdom.
- 7. Let us ask Mary, our blessed Mother, to intercede for us: Hail Mary ...
