## **Priest**

- For pupils and students, for teachers, and all who work in education; that the wisdom of God will inspire and direct them.
- 4. For all who are ill in body, mind, or spirit, and for everyone who has asked us to pray for them.
- 5. For our parish, and all who worship with us today; that our witness to the Saviour and care of those in need will draw others to the mystery of Christ.
- 6. For the faithful departed, who have recognised Jesus as their Saviour; that he will gather them to himself in the glory of the kingdom.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of our Saviour, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...

## **Priest**

Almighty and eternal God, when Christ was baptised in the river Jordan, the Holy Spirit came upon him and your voice declared him your beloved Son. Keep all who are reborn of water and the Spirit as children of adoption in whom you are well pleased.
