Reader

1. We pray for the Church throughout the world: that she will always be a redeeming grace to combat evil and violence.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

- 2. For all who are suffering persecution for their faith: may they find strength in knowing that God is with them and will always overcome evil.
- 3. For all who have strayed from the practice of their faith: that the body and blood of Christ they received in former years will be their saving grace, and draw them back to God and to the Church.
- 4. For all of us here: that through the worthy reception of Christ in Communion, we will be beacons, bringing God's light into the world.
- 5. That those who are sick in mind or body may be strengthened by the reception of the body and blood of Christ in the eucharist.
- 6. For all our deceased relatives and friends: that they may share in the eucharistic banquet, which they believed in while on earth.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
