Priest

Reader

1. We pray for the Church: that the Lord will turn his ear to us and answer our petitions.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For our Holy Father, Pope Francis, for Bishop Paul and all Bishops, for Father Geoffrey and all priests and religious: we give thanks for their vocations, and ask the Lord to inspire more young people to dedicate their lives to the service of God.
- 3. For all married couples: may their love for one another grow stronger as years go by.
- 4. For all that is good and beautiful in our world: may we give thanks for the lives of all plants and creatures so necessary to sustain life on earth.
- 5. For all who feel they have nothing to be thankful for and those who are suffering extreme hardships as a result of wars and strife: we pray especially for the people living in Afghanistan.
- 6. For all who are sick and those who care for them: that they may feel the love of the Lord around them.
- 7. For all who have died: may we give thanks for their lives and for the love we received from them.
- 8. We ask Mary, our Mother, to intercede for us as we say: Hail, Mary, ...
