- 3. For all who are making their First Holy Communion, especially our young parishioners, [Sat] Julia and Nathaniel / [Sun] Grace, that the Holy Spirit will enliven their faith, and enable them to follow Jesus their whole life long.
- 4. For governments, and the United Nations; that together they will seek the ways of peace, and bring an end to violence, terror, and injustice.
- 5. For all who are elderly, infirm, or ill, especially with Coid-19; that the Lord will be their help and strength.
- 6. For the faithful departed: all who have died recently, and those whose anniversary we keep; may they be welcomed into the presence of God.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to pray with us and for us: Hail, Mary, ...
