- 5. For a greater appreciation of the wonderful world which our Creator has given us: may there be strong commitment by governments and people to preserve and protect it for future generations.
- 6. For all who have died in the last year: family and friends, members of our parish, and those whom no one remembers: may our loving God welcome them into his heavenly kingdom.
