Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For an increase in vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life: may God raise up Good Shepherds in our midst.
- 3. For all who are preparing for Confirmation: may they be open to all the gifts that the Holy Spirit offers them, and may they enrich the Church with their talents and energy.
- 4. For an end to conflict around the world; for peace and reconciliation: we especially pray for the people caught up in the wars in the Holy Land, in Ukraine, and in Sudan.
- 5. For all the aid workers who voluntarily lay their lives on the line every day to bring help and succour to civilians caught up in wars not of their making: may the Lord give them the strength and courage they need.
- For all who have died, that they may be forever in God's presence; and for all those grieving the death of a loved one; that they may experience the compassion of the Lord in their pain.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of our Risen Lord, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary
