- For reconciliation and healing: between countries, different peoples and religions, within families and relationships.
- For all victims of the earthquake in Syria and Turkey: those who have been injured, or killed; those who are grieving; all who have lost their homes or livelihoods; we pray, too, for the work of the relief agencies.
- For those who are ill: our fellow parishioners, members of our families, and friends; that they may experience God's healing presence.
- For the faithful departed: those who have died recently, and all whose anniversaries we keep; that they will behold all that God has prepared for those who love him.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
