General Intercessions

Priest

Blessed are those who delight in the Lord;
and so, with great confidence, we pray for the Church and for the world.

Reader

1. We pray for Pope Francis, and all Bishops, priests, deacons, and religious:
that God in His love will show them the way
to guide us beyond the things of this earth to our home in heaven.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least five seconds, please. Repeat after each intention

Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.**

2. We pray for world leaders:
that, particularly at these times of uncertainty in Eastern Europe,
they listen to each other,
and come together to resolve mutual concerns
made worse by historical problems and political differences.
3. We pray for an end to racial injustice:
that all peoples recognise the need
to look beyond skin colour or differences in culture,
to see each other as we are in God's eyes,
and to treat each other with love and respect.
4. We pray for the sick and lonely of our parishes:
that they put their trust in God
and feel the strength of God's love around them.
5. We pray for all those who have died,
especially in our own families and who are held close to our hearts.
6. Let us ask Mary, our Mother, to join with us in our prayers: Hail Mary, ...
