- 3. For those deprived of the sacraments; may we be one in love and prayer with all who are not allowed to practice their faith and cannot receive the Lord in the eucharist.
- 4. For the leaders of the wealthy nations; may Jesus' concern for the hungry find a response in their hearts, so that no one in our world dies of hunger, or is forced to live in desperate conditions.
- 5. For an end to violence in our cities; that God will give courage to all who are working for peace, help the voices of those who have expressed injustice to be heard, and turn the hearts of those prone to violence towards new ways of working for change.
- 6. For all our loved ones who have died; that having shared the Bread of Life they may be raised in glory on the last day.
