Priest

Reader

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For all who are suffering in body, mind, or spirit, and those who care for them; that the risen Christ may be their beacon of hope.
- 3. For all who have lost their livelihood; and for anyone facing the threat of redundancy.
- 4. For peace throughout the world; that Jews, Christians, and Muslims will live in harmony, free from oppression and the threat of violence.
- For all those married in the Lord, those preparing to marry, and all who celebrate their wedding anniversary around this time; that God will nurture and sustain their love.
- 6. For the faithful departed: members of our parishes, friends, and family; that they will know the fullness of life with the Risen Lord;

O God of mystery, out of death you delivered Christ Jesus, and he walked in hidden glory with his disciples. Stir up our faith, that our hearts may burn within us at the sound of his word and our eyes be opened to recognise him in the breaking of the bread.
