Reader

- 5. For all who suffer in body, mind, or spirit, and those who care for them; that the risen Christ may be their beacon of hope.
- 6. For the faithful departed: members of our parish, friends, and family, that they will know the fullness of life with the Risen Lord.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Risen Lord, to join her prayers to ours: Hail Mary ...
