

Easter Triduum : The Resurrection of the Lord General Intercessions

Priest

Giving thanks to God,
who draws us into the mystery of his Son's death and resurrection,
we bring before God the needs of the Church and of the world.

Reader

1. For the Church:
that renewed through Word and Sacrament,
we may radiate the light of Christ,
be strong in faith, confident in hope,
and abounding in love for God and neighbour.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least five seconds. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.**

2. For all believers:
that Christ will pour out the Spirit upon us,
and enable us to continue the mission
of bringing hope, meaning, and love to all in our society.
3. For all who find themselves confused, doubting their faith,
or walking in darkness:
that they may experience the Risen Lord, who brings light and hope to hearts.
4. For all who have fled their homes because of violence or fear,
especially the people of Ukraine:
that God will guide them to safety, give them hope,
and touch the hearts of many to welcome and support them.
5. For peace:
that the Risen Lord will give each of us peace of mind and heart,
relief from stress and pressure,
and renew our spirits, so that we may live life fully each day.
6. For all who have touched and graced our lives,
and have gone before us in faith;
that they will rest in peace and rise in glory.
7. We ask Mary, Mother of Our Risen Lord, to intercede for us: Hail Mary, ...

favourably hear our prayer:
Restore in us your image,
renew in us your love,
and bring us at the last to the fullness of our hope,
where the risen Christ is Lord, for ever and ever.
