- 3. For those who are suffering and heavily burdened through bereavement or loss of employment: may they never forget that the Lord is with them in their struggle.
- 4. For all young people and their teachers who are beginning a new school year: may they return to their studies with enthusiasm and keep safe during their time in school.
- 5. For justice and peace throughout the world, especially at this time in America: may prejudice and violence cease, and a culture of acceptance prevail.
- 6. For the faithful departed: that the Lord will bring them safely into his kingdom.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary, ...
