Priest

Reader

 For the communion of the Church; that churches and Christian communities throughout the world will grow together in the unity for which Christ prayed.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds. Repeat after each intention. Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.**

- 2. For all who serve in public office; that they will be filled with a spirit of service, discernment of the common good, and the courage to act on it.
- 3. For the injured and the disabled, the mentally distressed, and those whose well-being has been weakened or destroyed, that they may know the presence of God's healing Spirit.
- 4. For all who are sitting examinations; that the Holy Spirit will guide and inspire them.
- 5. For all members of our parish, and all who gather with us today; that we may worship in spirit and in truth, and be faithful stewards of God's many gifts to us.
- 6. For the faithful departed; that God will raise them to life in the Spirit.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
