Pastoral Letter Our Bishop has sent a letter to parishes for the beginning of the Season of Lent. I've asked our Readers to read it because the Bishop is writing to all of us, priests and deacons as well as layfolk. It's important that I listen to it with you. Fr Geoffrey Coronavirus Precautions The Church is aware that parishioners may be concerned about hygiene precautions regarding the Coronavirus spread; in relation to blessing ourselves from the holy water stoop as we come and go from church, and in the receiving of Holy Communion, especially from the chalice. Normal hygiene precautions such as washing hands thoroughly, and using tissues to catch coughs and sneezes are important. Eucharistic ministers should also take special care when wiping the rim of the chalice between each person.
