Parish Finance and Property Committee – Following my note in 7th/8th December Weekly Bulletin I can now confirm that the Diocese will be visiting us to discuss and assess the proposed structural repairs to the Church Tower and the internal redecoration of the Church. At the Committee's last meeting members discussed at length not only these projects but also other requirements and issues relating to our Parish estate of which I have given a brief overview below. These include necessary works needed to our Community Centre, which was subject to a Quinquennial Survey in 2017, management of Parish Health & Safety issues and compliance with the recently issued updated Diocesan "Parish Property Management Guide." We also need to look at Fundraising which will be a factor in how and when improvements to our Parish can be carried out. There also remains an ongoing range of items of work, many minor but which all cost money, which require attention. Whilst the above covers Property issues, central to all of this is finance, and so I am asking for two additional volunteer members of this committee. One would require relevant financial experience and one should have relevant property management experience. It is suggested that the roles be time limited, say for 3 years. The Committee currently meets around six times a year. In addition, it is possible some of the above roles could be done on an ad hoc basis which could involve liaising with the Committee without having to be part of it or attending meetings. Please let me know if you can help with this. I would be pleased to have an informal chat with those who may be interested.
