<u>Welcome</u> to Fr Ted Gannon, who is presiding at our Masses this weekend while Fr Geoffrey is on his post-Christmas break. Fr Ted is currently Priest in Residence at St Gregory's, Preston, from where he exercises his ministry of spiritual direction and formation in prayer.

<u>CAFOD Special Collection</u> – There is a special collection in both parishes this weekend for CAFOD's work to help relieve the famine taking hold in Zimbabwe and Zambia. Crippling drought and spiralling food prices continue to worsen the food shortages in both countries. CAFOD along with local Church aid workers have been working around the clock to get food and clean water to communities in need. CAFOD's Zambia representative, Mwila Mulumbi, has said "People have run out of ways to cope, and are forced to survive on wild fruits and leaves". To help with the fund-raising, there are Parish Quiz sheets available from the back of both Churches (suggested donation £1 with prize of a small Fairtrade hamper for most correct answers).
