## Listed places of worship grant scheme: update

Heritage Minister, Sir Chris Bryant, has announced that the Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme will be extended for one year from March 2025.

The scheme - which has run since 2001 - allows listed places of worship of all faiths to reclaim VAT on essential repair works, and we have benefitted very much from that.

However, the extended scheme will operate with a reduced overall budget and a funding cap of £25,000 per place of worship. The total funding limit for the coming year is £23 million, down from the £29 million last year.
