Decorating St Mary & St Michael's

I am very pleased to be able to tell you that work will soon begin on the expanse of wall near the pulpit, where the paint was damaged by water ingress, now resolved.

The flaking paint will be removed, the plaster checked and, depending on how the bare wall looks, it will be repainted.

Work will begin first on the sections of similarly damaged wall in the balcony, to test any new paint before applying it in the more visible area of the church.

This work will be paid for from an anonymous recent donation. Our sincere thanks to the generous donor.

Redecorating the whole church will be a major project. It will need to be planned and executed with great care, and with respect for the historic fabric. A quotation from 2018 was over £100,000. We can assume an increase of 40% on that by now. (We do not have these funds, ... yet.)
