Season of Advent : Sunday 4B General Intercessions

Priest

God's love lasts for ever; God's truth is firmly established as the heavens. In this season of hope, let us pray for the Church and for the world.

Reader

1. For the Church:

may our hearts be a fitting dwelling place for God to enable us to bring his presence to all those we meet.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. In these days, leading up to the Lord's Nativity, let us pray for a listening heart: that we, like Mary, may ponder God's invitation, and give our full "yes" to all that God asks of us.
- 3. For all women awaiting the birth of a child: that they may feel God's presence with them, and that their children be born healthy and strong.
- 4. For all who are isolated and alone at Christmas, especially those who are in hospital or care homes, and those who are homeless: may Christ fill their emptiness, and open our hearts to reach out to them.
- 5. Let us pray for peace and goodwill to all; we pray especially for the people of the Holy Land region and Ukraine: may the Lord turn human hearts from violence and domination to resolve disputes with word and deeds of compassion.
- 6. For all who have died: that the coming of Christ may open for them the eternal joy and peace of God's presence.
- 7. We ask Mary, Blessed Mother of our Lord, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary

Pour forth, O Lord, your grace into our hearts: once through the message of an angel you revealed to us the incarnation of Christ your Son; now through his passion and cross lead us to the glory of his resurrection, who lives and reigns for ever and ever.
