5. For all who are suffering:

may God bring healing to the sick, relief to those experiencing drought, renewal to those who have suffered from abuse or crime, and new opportunities for those seeking employment.

- 6. For those who have died: may they be at peace in the loving presence of the Lord.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of our Risen Lord, to intercede with him for us: Hail, Mary,
