- 4. For all who are leaving school or college; that God will guide them in the decisions they face; for all who work in education, that God grant them a restful break.
- For all who are travelling this weekend, that they may reach their destination safely; we pray, too, for all who cannot take a holiday this summer.
- 6. For the faithful departed; especially those who have died recently, and all whose anniversary we keep around this time.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers to ours: Hail Mary ...
