Reader

1. For the Church:

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For an end to the divisions which damage Christ's Body, the Church: that Christians will be able to give united and convincing witness to the Gospel.
- For peace throughout the world; for an end to conflict and violence everywhere.
- 4. As we prepare to mark Holocaust Memorial Day in this country, we remember all victims of genocide; we pray for those who commit such crimes, that they will repent; and we pray for ourselves, that hatred and discrimination will be far from our heart.
- 5. For those who are ill, and all who care for them; that they may know God's healing grace.
- For all who have gone before us in faith; that they will know the blessing of life in the Holy Trinity.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
