- 5. For our parishes, and all who worship with us today; that our witness to the Gospel and our care of those in need will draw others to know Jesus Christ.
- 6. For the faithful departed: all who have died recently, and those whose anniversary we keep; may they be welcomed into the presence of God.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...
