- 4. For refugees from violence, oppression, hunger, or natural disaster; for all who are homeless in our own land.
- 5. For all who are ill, and those who care for them; that they will know the comforting presence of their Saviour.
- For all the faithful departed: our own friends and family, and the members of our parish who have died over the past year; that God will grant them a full share in the resurrection of Christ.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
