## **General Intercessions**

#### **Priest**

Truly God's decrees are to be trusted; and so with confidence we can pray for the Church and for the world.

#### Reader

1. For the whole Church; that our worship and our lives will proclaim Christ's kingdom, and draw others to believe in him.

**PAUSE** for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For our young people, their families, and all who help them to grow in Christian faith; we pray in particular for our Diocesan Youth Service, and for the team at Castlerigg Manor.
- 3. For young people who cannot find work, for those who are homeless, and those whose lives are blighted by addiction.
- 4. For the peoples of the world; that governments and all who serve in politics will work closer together to promote the common good of all God's children.
- 5. For all members of our parishes, and for everyone here today; that we will listen to the voice of Christ our King, and bear witness to the truth.
- 6. For the faithful departed: our own friends and family, and the members of this parish who have died over the last year, that they may enjoy the fullness of life in Christ's kingdom.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary ...
