General Intercessions

Priest

The Lord is a God of tenderness and compassion;
and the Holy Spirit enables us to pray in the name of Jesus Christ
with the confidence of those who know that God will hear our prayer.

Reader

1. For Jews, Christians, and Muslims who all believe in the one true God;
that holy wisdom will direct us in the ways of peace.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least five seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.**

2. For our parishes;
that God will enable us to recognise and acknowledge our gifts and talents,
and grant us the courage and confidence to use them well.
3. For peace throughout the world;
that all peoples will be able to live without the threat of war, terror, or violence,
oppression or prejudice.
4. For all who are sitting examinations,
especially the members of our own parish;
that God will guide and bless them in their work.
5. For all who are ill,
whether at home, in hospital, the hospice, or in one of the care homes;
for anyone who has asked for our prayers.
6. For the faithful departed:
those who have died recently, and all whose anniversary we keep;
may they enjoy the fullness of life with the Blessed Trinity.
7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers to ours: Hail Mary ...

you revealed the wonderful mystery of the Godhead
by sending into the world
the Word who speaks all truth
and the Spirit who makes us holy.

Grant that we may proclaim the fullness of faith
by acknowledging and worshipping
three persons, eternal in glory,
one God of majesty and power.
