Church sound system Garstang -Some improvements to the microphones have already been carried out: the new lectern mic will better serve readers of different height and is more discrete; the antennas for the radio mics are now in church rather than in the sacristy, and are no longer compromised by the thick stone walls. We will achieve even better speech clarity and quality with a new loudspeaker system. This will cover more of the congregation per loudspeaker and will also restrict the sound currently radiated to the ceiling, which returns as reverberation and masks speech clarity. We will also improve the loop system; this will reduce background noise and give a more constant and consistent output. This work will be carried out later this month, at a cost of £5,000.
