<u>Do you support Catholic Schools</u> and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. They have acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and promised to abandon it, now we need you to tell them not to u-turn on their promise to Catholics. <u>Tabor</u> – The Discalced Carmelite Friars announced in May 2017 that, due to a shortage of personnel, Tabor Carmelite Retreat Centre was to close. The Carmelites immediately sought a group who would buy Tabor to continue the Christian ministry there. With the Statement of the Provincials of the Order of Discalced Carmelites and the Xaverian Missionaries, on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2017, we were delighted to receive the news that there was an agreement, in principle, to sell the property to the Xaverian Missionaries. This will ensure continuity of the ethos and work of Tabor. We understand that there will be a period of transition before Tabor re-opens probably in early 2018.

<u>Mission Boxes</u> – Would you please bring your Mission Boxes to be emptied to church next weekend. *Thank you*.

Apostleship of the Sea – There is a campaign whereby people can send a Christmas card (or greeting cards/Mass cards at any time) to be forwarded to seafarers in various ports whom they feel are isolated and lonely and who will be comforted by people's thoughts and prayers. A selection of blank Christmas cards will be provided at the back of the church, for people to add a message and sign (first name only, no contact details), and a box for their collection.
